STRANDS

Strands Snickeri, a carpentry from the 1940s, with its 1,300 m², it becomes a branch of existing operations. The property was acquired by Not Quite on October 1, 2021. New workshops and studios will be built here and new sustainable businesses will be developed.



FENGERSFORS BRUK

Fengersfors paper mill and society share their history with many other paper mills around Sweden. It was founded as an iron mill in the 1790s and later became a paper mill in the early 20th century, to install the world's first continuous boiler in 1949. In 1978 it went bankrupt and in 2002 the Not Quite artist cooperative began to establish and build up workshops and galleries on the old mill site.



FOLKETS HUS

Fengersfors Community House was built in the 40:ies for the workers at Fengersfors Paper Mill for recreational activities. The, sometimes wild, dance events are still present in the memories of the good old times. The last couple of years the community house association has revived the building with community service projects..



KLEVA SLOYD BIOTOPE

Kleva Sloydbiotope is a piece of land designated to experimentation within the crafts, arts and architecture, all in a social setting.

You will find information desks in the entrance of Folkets hus and Ocean floor 1. Accreditation takes place Thursday 10am-6pm, Friday 9:30am-5pm in the Folkets hus entrance.

Opposite the paper mill is a grocery store. Here you will find, besides Fengersfors' nicest staff, most of what you need in the form of food and sweets.

In addition to participating in our busy program, take the opportunity of taking a trip in the forest, on the mountains and around the lakes (see the map for more details). Remember the Swedish right of public access - you can pick berries and mushrooms but not break off branches or pull plants up by the roots. Of course, you also throw your waste in designated bins so that the forest and village of Fengersfors are kept clean and tidy.

We are happy that in cooperation with local associations we can also offer you one of the most Swedish things there is - **FIKA** - coffee with a cake that is so necessary. Thank you Fengersfors community house, Fengersfors athletic club and Årrojöblomman's scout troop!
